## Introduction

The purpose of the Character in Action program is to focus on developing Christ-like character in our children.

- Our **Mission** is to lead all children to be fully devoted followers of Christ.
- Our **Vision** is to invite all kids to know Christ in a way that transforms their daily lives and the lives of those around them.
- Our **Goal** is to assist parents in discipling their children to develop and demonstrate the character of Christ.

These character qualities have been divided into a four-year revolving program. Leaders are challenged with reviewing the character qualities and developing age-appropriate lessons for their “club”. Additionally, they are asked to intersperse their message with the Good News of the Gospel! That Christ died for our sins and that in confessing and repenting of our sins, believing that Christ rose again and conquered death, and giving our lives to Him we will have eternal life and not the condemnation of hell. What a wonderful message to share!

The Leaders instruct and demonstrate to children that doing things God’s way will allow the Lord to work in their lives and help avoid the consequences of sin. Leaders introduce qualities, that if adopted, will make children both good citizens and (if saved) living examples of our Lord.

## Overview

Each week clubs will have the opportunity to memorize scripture and receive instruction on a character quality. There is a lesson that corresponds with each character quality for the week, with specific activities to help engraft God's Word into your children and learn to both recognize these character qualities as well as demonstrate them in action.

Children will be asked to recite the character quality definition and scripture verse each week for the character quality on which we're focused! Only after this is accomplished can they receive "points" for the other memory work or activities in that lesson. Memory work or activities are followed by a

 which leaders will sign and date. A point will be given for each assignment completed. Once all the assignments for the lessons of each character quality have been completed in its entirety, then the child will receive an award sticker on their badge for that character quality. There are assignments throughout the book that will require adult help. So, please enjoy this opportunity to teach God's character to your children!

Additionally, there are extra credit memory sections in the back of the book to memorize additional Scripture. ABC Verses Galatians 5, and James 2 will earn an extra credit point per verse. Matthew 5, Matthew 6, and Matthew 7 do not earn points, but when each chapter is memorized and quoted word-perfect to the church, it will reap big rewards at the end of the year, but the greatest of these rewards will be the knowledge of God's Word.

## 3.4 Practice Alertness



Being alert is an attitude of paying attention and being ready to do what is right.

Alertness makes us aware of dangers that threaten to weaken or destroy the resources God has entrusted to us and that we must exercise extreme care in protecting these resources. The biblical words are *beware* and *vigilance*.

In the Bible, three Greek words are translated to *beware*:

- *Blepo* meaning “to perceive or observe” (Col 2:8, Phil 3:2)
- *Phulasso* conveying the idea of sentry guarding a prisoner (Luke 12:15, 2 Pet 3:17)
- *Prosecho* meaning “to give attention to, be cautious about, to devote thought to” (Matt 7:15, Luke 12:1)

Vigilance is translated through the Greek word:

- *Gregoreuo* meaning “to take heed lest through remission and indolence some destructive calamity suddenly overtakes one.” (1 Pet 5:8)

**Matthew 5:26** Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.

**Matthew 5:27** Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery:

**Matthew 5:28** But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

**Matthew 5:29** And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

**Matthew 5:30** And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast *it* from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not *that* thy whole body should be cast into hell.

**Matthew 5:31** It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement:

**Matthew 5:32** But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery.

**Matthew 5:33** Again, ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, Thou shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths:

**Matthew 5:34** But I say unto you, Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne:

**Matthew 5:35** Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.

**Matthew 5:36** Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.

**Matthew 5:37** But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil.

**Matthew 5:38** Ye have heard that it hath been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth:

**Matthew 5:39** But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.

**Matthew 5:40** And if any man will sue thee at the law, and take away thy coat, let him have *thy* cloke also.

**Matthew 5:41** And whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain.

**Matthew 5:42** Give to him that asketh thee, and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away.

**Matthew 5:43** Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy.

**Matthew 5:44** But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

**Matthew 5:45** That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

**Matthew 5:46** For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?

**Matthew 5:47** And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more *than others*? do not even the publicans so?

**Matthew 5:48** Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

# Matthew 6

(KJV)

**Matthew 6:1** Take heed that ye do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.

**Matthew 6:2** Therefore when thou doest *thine* alms, do not sound a trumpet before thee, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**Matthew 6:3** But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth:

**Matthew 6:4** That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly.

**Matthew 6:5** And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites *are*: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**Matthew 6:6** But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

**Matthew 6:7** But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen *do*: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

**Matthew 6:8** Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.

**Matthew 6:9** After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

**Matthew 6:10** Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as *it is* in heaven.

**Matthew 6:11** Give us this day our daily bread.

**Matthew 6:12** And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

**Matthew 6:13** And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

**Matthew 6:14** For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

**Matthew 6:15** But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

**Matthew 6:16** Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

**Matthew 6:17** But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face;

**Matthew 6:18** That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.

**Matthew 6:19** Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

**Matthew 6:20** But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

**Matthew 6:21** For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

**Matthew 6:22** The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

**Matthew 6:23** But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in thee be darkness, how great *is* that darkness!

**Matthew 6:24** No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

**Matthew 6:25** Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

**Matthew 6:26** Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

**Matthew 6:27** Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?

**Matthew 6:28** And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:

**Matthew 6:29** And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

**Matthew 6:30** Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, *shall he* not much more *clothe* you, O ye of little faith?

**Matthew 6:31** Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

**Matthew 6:32** (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

**Matthew 6:33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

**Matthew 6:34** Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day *is* the evil thereof.

# Matthew 7

(KJV)

**Matthew 7:1** Judge not, that ye be not judged.

**Matthew 7:2** For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

**Matthew 7:3** And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

**Matthew 7:4** Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam *is* in thine own eye?

**Matthew 7:5** Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

**Matthew 7:6** Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

**Matthew 7:7** Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

**Matthew 7:8** For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

**Matthew 7:9** Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

**Matthew 7:10** Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

**Matthew 7:11** If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

**Matthew 7:12** Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

**Matthew 7:13** Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

**Matthew 7:14** Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

**Matthew 7:15** Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

**Matthew 7:16** Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

**Matthew 7:17** Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

**Matthew 7:18** A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither *can* a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

**Matthew 7:19** Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

**Matthew 7:20** Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

**Matthew 7:21** Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

**Matthew 7:22** Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

**Matthew 7:23** And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

**Matthew 7:24** Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

**Matthew 7:25** And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

**Matthew 7:26** And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

**Matthew 7:27** And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

**Matthew 7:28** And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

**Matthew 7:29** For he taught them as *one* having authority, and not as the scribes.
