Introduction

The Church at North Pole Youth Ministry has but one goal: to introduce youth to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. To do this, the ministry revolves around training the character qualities of Christ as outlined in *The Power for True Success: How to Build Character in Your Life*, published by the Institute in Basic Life Principles, Inc. We have divided these character qualities into a four-year revolving program.

Leaders are challenged with reviewing the character qualities and developing age-appropriate lessons for their "club." Additionally, they are required to intersperse their lessons with the Good News of the Gospel! In essence, that Gospel message is that Christ died for our sins, and by confessing and repenting of our sins, believing that Christ rose again and conquered death, and giving our lives to Him, we will have eternal life and not the condemnation of hell. What a wonderful message to share!

The club leaders and the lessons they develop are to instruct and demonstrate to children that doing things God's way will allow the Lord to work in their lives and enable the avoidance of the consequences of sin. In demonstrating and training character, leaders have the opportunity to introduce qualities, that, if adopted, will make children both good citizens and (if saved) living examples of our Lord.

Overview

Our ministry will focus on training the character qualities of Christ. Each week clubs will have the opportunity to memorize scripture and receive instruction on each character quality. There is a lesson that corresponds with each character quality for the week, with specific activities to help engraft God's Word into your children.

Children will be asked to recite the character quality definition and scripture verse each week for the character quality on which we're focused! Only after this is accomplished can they receive points for the other memory work or activities in that lesson. Memory work or activities are followed by a block which leaders will sign and date. A point will be given for each assignment accomplished. Once all the assignments for both lessons of a character quality have been completed in its entirety, the child will receive an award for that character quality. If a child completes all the assignments in the designated lesson for that week, then they will earn an extra point for the week. Refer to the Parent Handbook to see what the designated lesson is for each week. There are assignments throughout the book that will require adult help, so enjoy this opportunity to teach God's character to your children.

Additionally, there are extra credit sections in the back of the book (ABCs of Character, Matthew 5, Matthew 6, and Matthew 7). Each verse from the ABCs of Character that is memorized and quoted to their leader will be signed off, and they will receive an extra point for the CIA store. The Matthew 5, 6, and 7 sections do not earn points, but when each chapter is memorized and quoted word-perfect to the church, it will reap big rewards at the end of the year, greatest being the knowledge of God's Word.

Have archaeologists found Noah's Ark in Turkey? Radar scans done on the boat-like structure discovered near the mountains of Ararat showed pieces of wood that appear to be part of a huge boat. The scans revealed keels, keelsons, gunnels, bulkheads, and even empty rooms, a ramp, a door in the right front, and an open central area. A scan of the area outside the structure found no iron, but a scan inside showed at least 5,400 separate spots where iron was detected. Each of those spots was either on lines running the structure's length or on lines running its width. Check out the photos above. What do you think? Does it look like a boat to you? Did you know there are more than 500 legends worldwide about a global Flood? Many stories include the warning of a coming flood, a boat, animals, and a family.

Matthew 7:5 Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Matthew 7:6 Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

Matthew 7:7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

Matthew 7:8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Matthew 7:9 Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

Matthew 7:10 Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

Matthew 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

Matthew 7:12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.

Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

Matthew 7:14 Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Matthew 7:16 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

Matthew 7:17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

Matthew 7:18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither *can* a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

Matthew 7:19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

Matthew 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Matthew 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

Matthew 7:25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

Matthew 7:26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

Matthew 7:27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

Matthew 7:28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

Matthew 7:29 For he taught them as *one* having authority, and not as the scribes.
